CLUB POLICY AND RULES 1-1-2021

Archery Ranges

- 1. NO Broadheads or Blunts allowed on Club Target bags.
- 2. Members may bring and use their own Broadhead targets on Practice Ranges.
- 3. Make sure the target and the area behind is clear before shooting.
- 4. Shoot from pins and or shooting stations only.
- 5. Shoot only at targets.
- 6. Take Trash and broken arrows with you.
- 7. KEEP RANGES CLEAN !!!!
- 8. Club Indoor Ranges are available for practice during club hours.

Club Hunting and Trapping

- 1. NO GUEST HUNTING OR TRAPPING.
- 2. Archery hunting for Deer is allowed on Club Property. Hunters are allowed to take 1 Deer per hunter/ per year. Hunters MUST follow all PGC Laws and Seasons.
- 3. No Hunting with Firearms on Club Property.
- 4. Trapping is allowed on club property. Members must get pre-approval from club officers and follow all PGC Laws and Seasons.

<u>Trap Ranges</u>

- 1. 1. EYE and HEARING protection is REQUIRED at ALL TIMES by SHOOTERS and SPECTATORS.
- 2. Range Cards MUST be displayed at all times.
- 3. Do not change shooting stations with a loaded gun.
- 4. Actions remain open when not shooting.
- 5. Do not track targets unless you are on the firing line.
- 6. A Manual Thrower is available for practice use.
- 7. Target loads only (#6 max, 1350'/sec max.)
